Aims & Objectives

Opportunities

The community is encouraged to attend Parish Council meetings and actively take part in any discussions. The Parish Office (as above) welcomes members of the public to visit and raise any issues of concern.

The Council will endeavour to bring to the attention of the community any consultations by other partners i.e. Borough Councils/County Councils/NHS/Police etc.

Cranbrook & Sissinghurst Parish Council will facilitate a meeting if there is a specific item that is in the interest of our parishioners i.e. planning or transport issues.

Roles of Members and Clerks

All Parish Council Members abide by the Kent Code of Conduct and are available at all reasonable times to speak with parishioners. The Clerks are available during normal office hours, but particularly on the advertised opening hours of 10 am and 12 noon.
